Goal

To safely and effectively facilitate the vision of ITW (showing and sharing Jesus, making disciples, training guides & sending them out to multiply guides all over the world), ITW themes (God's calling, divine encounters, living life to the full & our calling as redeemed people), and ITW core adventure components (spiritual transformation, authentic community, character formation, skill acquisition, and leadership development).

Summary

- Adventure preparation – Participant preparation, pre-adventure paperwork, itinerary design and planning, food preparation, equipment preparation, participant orientation, etc.
- Facilitation of the ITW mission, values and core components while on the ITW adventure. Additionally, guides will teach rock climbing, backpacking, mountaineering, backcountry living, LNT practices, leadership development, etc.
- Adventure closure – Post-adventure paperwork, debrief with students and program director, equipment clean-up, food clean-up, etc.

ITW Values

The applicant must believe in the centrality, supremacy and lordship of Jesus Christ and desire to grow as a disciple of Jesus Christ. He or she is expected to mature in intimacy with Jesus, keeping Christ as the center of their life. He or she is expected to walk in the light with Christian believers, demonstrate the character of Jesus and walk in step with the Spirit daily. He or she must be competent integrating faith and prayer into their job description and be committed to living for God's glory. The applicant must read and agree to ITW's mission statement and doctrinal statement which can be found on the web site.

Qualifications

- 21 years of age
- Valid italian or international drivers license
- Able to drive manual transmission
- Proficient in one of the following areas: rock climbing, backpacking, and mountaineering
- Successful completion of ITW's reTRAIN course
- Minimum Wilderness First Aid (WFA) and CPR medical certification
- All guides are required to carry their own personal medical insurance throughout the summer.
